The Mission Committee at Covenant Reformed has provision in its mandate to provide financial support for qualifying student mission activities. If a Covenant Reformed student desires to apply for financial assistance to help offset the cost of a mission trip, a short questionnaire must be filled out and returned to the Mission Committee. The committee will then review the request and approve the request if appropriate. All approved requests are then sent to Council for review and approval. In order to give each request an adequate review by both the committee and the Council, we ask that all questionnaires be returned to the Mission Committee at least 90 days prior to the start date of the mission trip. Students may obtain a questionnaire from any Mission Committee member or their parish elder. We will publish reminders in the announcement bulletin later this year as students begin to consider mission trips for next year.
